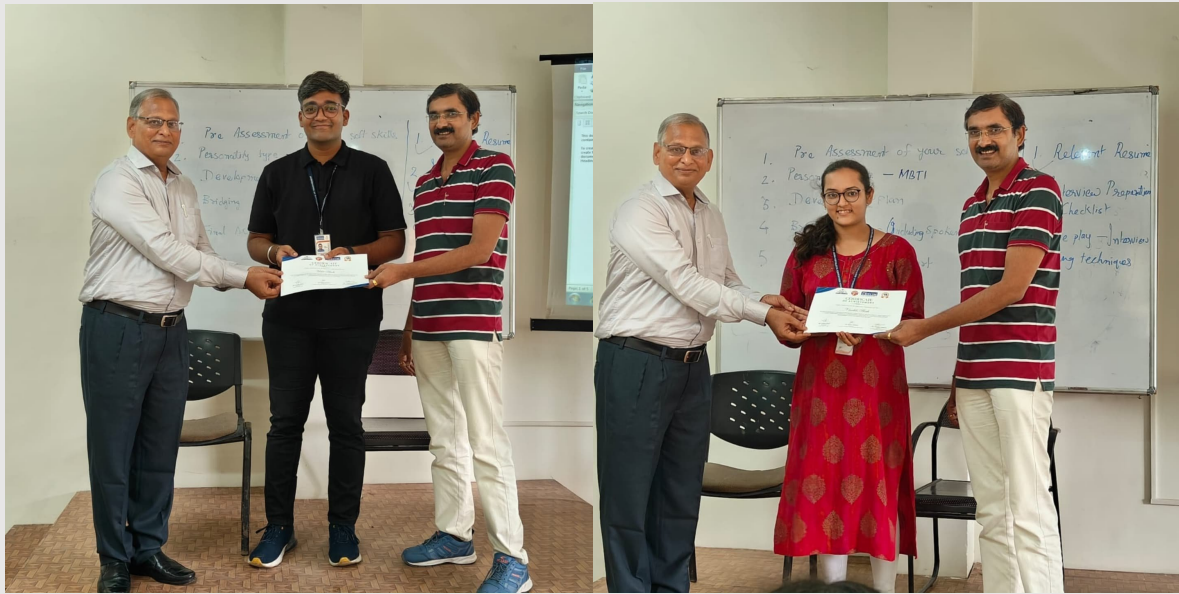

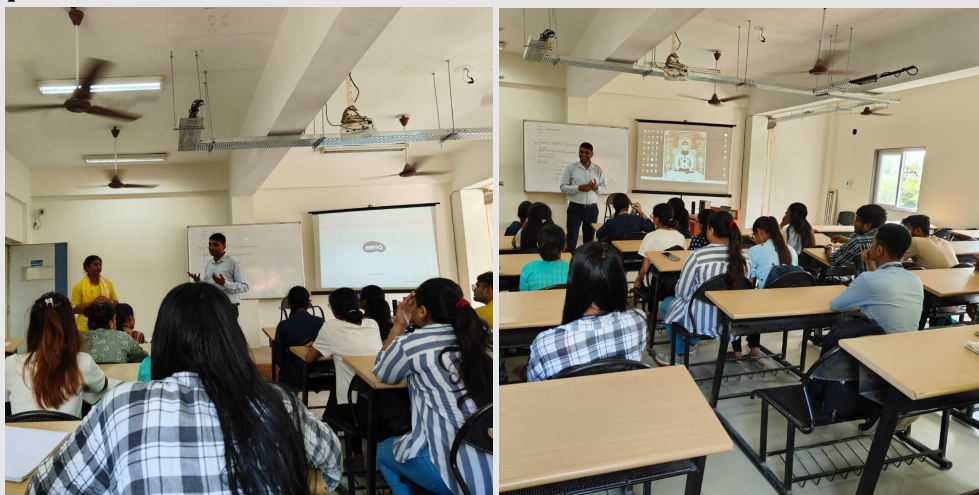
Celebrating Navaratri with Joy and Enthusiasm at CKSVIM

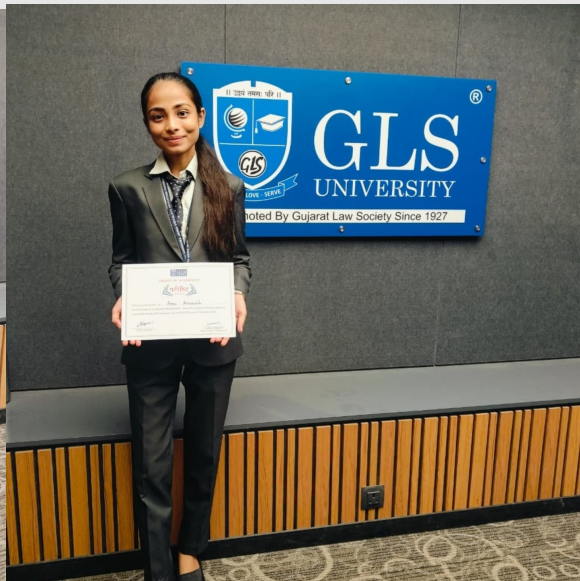
Alumni-Led Session on Placement Gap Analysis and Solutions for CKSVIM MBA Students
